2010 WINTER GAMES



The 2010 Vancouver Olympic and Paralympic Winter Games was a great success for both the competitors and PRIME BC which provided the core technology underpinnings to manage the security for the Games. Leveraging our experience from the 2002 Salt Lake City Olympic Games, Versaterm's CAD, RMS, MWS and Handhelds (BlackBerry) supported the Integrated Security Unit (ISU) and the 10,000 police officers and military personnel led by the Royal Canadian Mounted Police (RCMP).

With venues distributed throughout downtown Vancouver, Richmond, West Vancouver and Whistler, the Versadex capability to support the geographically dispersed area was an asset. At peak hours, over 3000 units were managed by the Versadex CAD system with a number of the officers using the Versadex Mobile Workstation and Handheld units to interact with CAD and query RMS, CPIC and the Police Information Portal (PIP).

As can be expected, providing security for the athletes, dignitaries and visitors was a massive undertaking and required additional staff to support the systems. RCMP Inspector Dennis Crowe, the Officer in Charge of Informatics for the ISU, commented that the ISU was very well prepared and staged to support the new users and widespread use of the Versadex system.

As all who witnessed the 2010 Winter Olympic and Paralympic games can agree, Vancouver demonstrated they are a world-class city and Versaterm is pleased to have contributed to the security of this, our 2nd Olympiad.
