Evolution of Safety Measures in Educational Institutions

Prior to 1999, most school safety measures consisted of practice drills in preparation for fire or natural disasters, such as tornadoes. The focus shifted due to the increasing number of deadly school incidents. New laws began to be passed that addressed this increased risk and ensure greater school safety.

According to the National Conference of State Legislatures (NCSL), over 2,000 school safety related bills were introduced in 52 states and territories between 2018 and 2022. Of those, almost 400 were adopted or enacted and another 300+ are still pending. Bill topics varied widely; examples include increasing mental health services and funding additional law enforcement and school resource officers.

Historically, schools have used physical methods to ensure the safety of students and staff, such as fences, metal detectors, and security cameras. This solely reactive focus has shifted due to the dynamic nature of school safety and educational institutions wanting to add proactive approaches.

Noticing signs or trends of issues before they grow into a real problem has become important. However, maintaining paper-based records and siloed data for managing at-risk students' cases is no longer efficient. This is where technology can help.

A Proactive Approach to Safety

One of the key elements in keeping students safe today is the threat assessment team. These groups play an important role in assessing and managing potential risks within educational institutions. These teams work to recognize threatening behavior, identify who should be informed about threats, establish threat assessment policies, and report data on their assessments. By bringing together professionals like counselors, teachers, and security personnel, they create a support system that's not just reactive but also proactive.

According to the Pew Research Center, around 64% of all schools in the United States reported having a threat assessment team in place during the 2019-2020 school year. Growing by more than 20% since 2016, it's clear that these teams are likely to remain important for school safety in the future.
